

CHOIR FUNDRAISERS

WHY SHOULD I FUND RAISE? Each student has a Student Account where we keep the money you earn for you to use for expenses associated with trips, choir fees, event tickets, costumes, field trips, voice lessons or anything attached to the fine arts at Hersey. You will get a monthly statement of how much you have in your account and how much you owe.

Taking advantage of these fundraisers will make the financial obligations much easier to handle.

Students will earn 90% of the profit from the sale and cap+s will earn 10% which will be put toward our scholarship fund.

Here's a list of our fundraisers and how you can earn \$\$\$ for your account:

LOU MALNATI CERTIFICATES – You sell gift certificates for Lou Malnati's frozen pizzas. We fill you order and deliver certificates to you.

FALL MUM & STRAW BALE SALE – **August – September** -- Fall mum planters and straw bales straight from the grower, Tom's Farm Market in Huntley. Awesome quality! Orders will be due September 12 - delivery September 26.

MATTRESS SALE – **Saturday, September 23** -We know it sounds unusual that we would be selling mattresses but this has been a very successful and lucrative fundraiser for the choir. The JHHS Cafeteria is set up just like a mattress store and we sell brand name quality mattresses --- all students have to do is to get referrals in to see the mattresses and if they sell one, they will get credit. You can earn approx:

twin/twin xl	\$50
full/queen	\$75
king/cal king	\$100

If the sale is student referred and the purchaser brings in a flyer, an **additional \$25** on top of these amounts (so \$75/\$100 and \$125 respectively) will be paid to the Student Account. So if you've been putting off purchasing a mattress, shop at JHHS for name brand mattresses while earning money for your Student Account.....tell friends and family!

CASINO NIGHT – Saturday, September 23 – 6:30 – 11 PM – Adult only evening!

FALL GALA - **Sunday, October 29–Cotillion Banquets** Students have fun while modeling or singing and attendees will enjoy lunch, an amazing Silent Auction, great entertainment and fun. Event is for the entire family including dads. **Students will earn \$5 for every Fall Gala ticket you sell.** Tables seat 10 – if you sell a table, \$50 goes in your account. We also sell **raffle tickets and you get 50%** of what you sell. Tickets are \$3 each, 6 for \$15 and 12 for \$25. Every choir student is expected to sell at least 12 tickets and showchoir students are expected to sell at least 24 tickets.

COOKIE DOUGH/GIFT ITEMS/MAGAZINE SALE – Sale starts mid November and cookie dough is delivered in early December. Although cookie dough is the main item sold, there are many gift items/magazines that can be bought thru a catalog. Also available for online sales so you can sell to your friends and family out of town! You will earn 90% of your profit for your student account.

SPRING FLOWER SALE – **late February/early March** – Orders are taken for a wide range of spring plants – flats of flowers – all varieties both sun and shade, hanging baskets, patio pots, veggies, herbs, fountain grass.....plants are grown for us at a wholesaler, Tom's Farm Market in Huntley, and delivered

on the Saturday of our Rummage Sale in May. **GORGEOUS** plants of outstanding quality. We have had several students earn well over \$100 with this fundraiser – one girl raised \$960!!!

GIFT CARD FUNDRAISER (formerly known as Manna) – This is a monthly sale of gift cards that can be used for everything from buying groceries, filling your tank with gas, buying gifts, going out to eat.....anything you usually spend cash on, you can get a gift card for ---- students earn varying percentages for their student account and cap+s earns a small donation to the scholarship fund.

EAT & SHARE DAYS – Each month with have an Eat & Share event at a local restaurant. Great time to get together with other choir families while earning money for the cap+s scholarship fund which helps to fund those in need in choir as well as students wishing to attend summer music camps.
