# HOW TO SIGN UP FOR REMIND 101 DIRECTIONS

1. BOTH PARENTS AND STUDENTS MUST SIGN UP FOR REMIND 101.
2. Find the SIGN UP instruction sheet for your particular choir and show choir (ATTACHED).

**IMPORTANT:** Instructions for each class are on the attached sheets. You must sign up for every ensemble you are in. For example, if you are in Chamber Singers, OnStage and Dickens Carolers, you (student and parent) must each sign up three times (once each for the three different ensembles). You will be responsible for the information sent out by Ms. Michael on Remind so you **MUST** sign up. This is **NOT** optional. This is a class requirement.

3. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS TO SIGN UP.
4. **YOU MUST BE SIGNED UP BY FRIDAY, AUGUST 25.** STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE A QUIZ GRADE FOR COMPLETION OF SIGN UP.

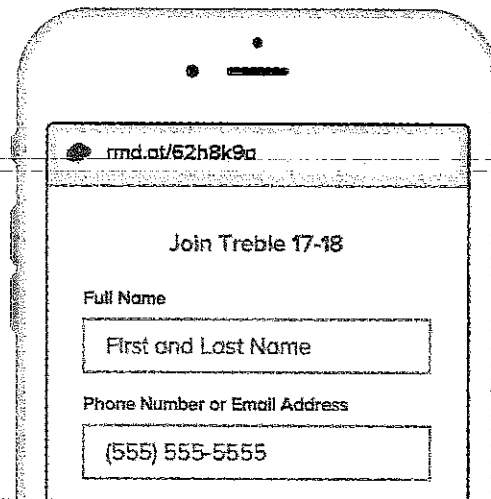

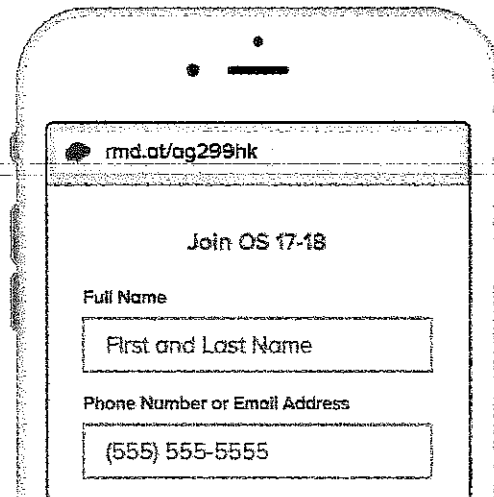

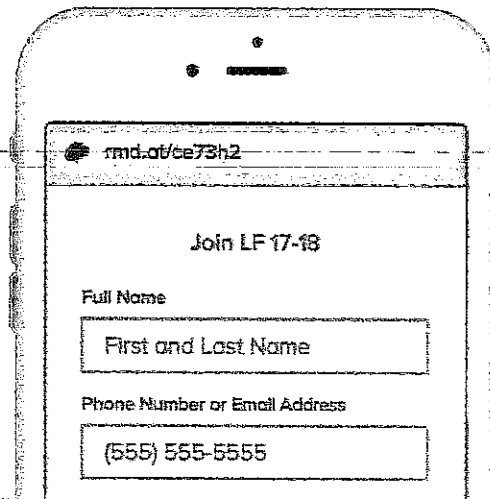

# What is Remind and what makes Remind safe?

**Remind is a free communication platform built for teachers. 36 million people use Remind and we're in half of all U.S. public schools.**

Remind allows teachers to safely and efficiently communicate with students & parents about important classroom information and school activities. Participants sign up as a student or parent and choose to receive messages by text, email, or in our app.

We know that privacy and security are important issues when dealing with teacher-to-student and teacher-to-parent communication. We have worked hand in hand with administrators and teachers to design key product features based on those concerns.

Here is a bit more detail about our free messaging service and the restrictions we have in place to ensure privacy and safety:

**No exchange of personal information:** Remind messages are not sent from personal cell phone numbers. Students/parents who sign up to get messages through Remind do not gain access to a teacher's personal cell phone number, nor will the teacher ever have access to a student or parent's personal information.

**Logged communication history:** A log of all 1 and 2-way messages are saved in a teacher's account and on our server. These messages cannot be edited or deleted within a teacher's account. This means an accurate log of communication history is at your fingertips should you need to review past content. This message history is also available for export so you can share with a Principal or parent.

**Report to Remind:** Keeping the Remind community safe is our priority, but it is a shared responsibility. We have posted our Community Guidelines to help everyone understand how to stay safe on Remind. If you need to report anyone to Remind, you may choose *Report* by clicking on any participant's name after clicking on the ( i ) Info

button.

**Personal information never shared or sold:** We do not rent, share, or sell user information. The only people with access to user data are the ones needed to operate our service. It's important to us that we only use your user information carefully and respectfully, so there are also no ads in our service.

Teachers have been seeing huge benefits from adding text messaging into their teaching strategy. We see increases in homework completion, improved test scores, class participation, parent involvement, and overall student motivation on a regular basis.

As a teacher using Remind, it's important that your school has given you permission to use Remind. If you will be messaging students, it is also important that you notify parents who can review our Terms of Service and Privacy Policy on behalf of their child.

# Does someone need a smartphone to use Remind?

No, a smartphone is not necessary to send or receive Remind messages. However, to receive Remind messages, you must be able to receive texts. If you cannot receive texts, you can sign up to receive Remind notifications by email.

You can also use Remind via the website by logging into your account at [www.remind.com](http://www.remind.com). We also just released the Remind app for Mac!

We don't have plans to build a Windows app at the moment.

If you have a Windows phone or Surface tablet, it's possible to log into your Remind account via the mobile browser as a teacher. This is a great option if you'd like to be sending messages while on the go.

# How do I join a class?

You can join a class to receive Remind messages via text, email, or push notification (or any combination of these).

## 1 To get text notifications:

### ▶ Join by text:

Participants text a unique class code to a Remind phone number. For U.S teachers, the Remind number is 81010. For example, if you wanted to join a class with the class code @math, you would text @math to 81010.



### ▶ Join online:

Visit [remind.com/join](https://remind.com/join) and enter the class code along with your mobile phone number. You'll get text notifications at the number you entered.

## 2 Get mobile app notifications.

Download the mobile app for iOS and Android devices and create a new account (or log in if you already have one.) To join a class, tap the + by Classes Joined and either join with your class code or search for your class. You'll automatically get app notifications.

## 3 Get email notifications.

### ▶ Join online:

Visit [remind.com/join](https://remind.com/join) and enter the class code and your email address.

### ▶ Join from your inbox:

Send a blank email to [code@mail.remind.com](mailto:code@mail.remind.com). (If the class code were @math, for example, you'd send a blank email to [math@mail.remind.com](mailto:math@mail.remind.com).) You'll get a response with more instructions.

If you don't have a class code, you can log in to your account to search for your class.
