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VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

FALLPALOOZA/KICK-OFF CONCERT – October 11 - Concert in the east gym. General choir information pre and post concert viewing. Good opportunity to get more detailed information on Choir program and to meet and greet other parents.

FALL GALA/FASHION SHOW/SILENT AUCTION - Sunday, October 28 at Cotillion Banquets in Palatine. This unique luncheon/fashion show features student/parent/faculty modeling fashions from a variety of local businesses. That afternoon will also include solos by choir students and an exciting Silent Auction and Raffle. This is a great family event.....moms, dads, relatives, neighbors are all encouraged to attend. If you want to help plan the fashion show, sell raffle tickets on the day of the event, help with table decorations, etc., volunteer and we'll give you a call.

FALL/SPRING FLOWER SALES – Mums, cornstalks, etc. sold in the fall brought to us straight from the grower – amazing quality. In the Spring, we sell potting plants and planters are ordered in January/February and grown specifically for each order. In both cases, you would organize the orders and help with pick up. Minimal time required.

CONCERT USHER - Take tickets and pass out programs at choral concerts.

CONCERT REFRESHMENTS - Provide punch and cookies after concert (cost covered by cap+s). Purchase items, set up and cleanup at a concert.

UNIFORM FITTING/CONCERT ATTIRE – Uniform fitting - Help with fitting of concert dresses either during the class day or during the evening at the beginning of the year. **Concert Attire Cleaning** - At the end of year, take 15 or so dresses home to wash.

FUNDRAISING CO-CHAIR – This position (along with another co-chair) will coordinate all the fundraisers – but not chair them. We will have people in charge of each.....you'll just need to coordinate organizational efforts.

CO-CHAIR INDIVIDUAL FUNDRAISERS – Basically, organize orders, place order with company and be here on delivery day. You'll get lots of help and support.

COOKIE DOUGH SALE - Early November - delivery Thanksgiving week. Tally student orders and place order with company. Take delivery and distribute to students on pick up day.

GRAPHIC DESIGN SHADOW/CO-CHAIR – Learn the job of designing our spirit wear and other graphic needs. Important to “brand” choir.

SHOPPING FOR SUPPLIES – When we run out of paper towel, kleenex, hand sanitizer, cough drops, etc., you simply go to the store, make the purchase and bring them to school. We'll tell you when we run out! You'll either use our credit card or cap+s will reimburse you.

CHICAGOLAND SHOWCASE – March 1 & 2 – Our **26th** anniversary this year! We need all parents to help with our biggest fundraiser of the year. This nationally-recognized showchoir competition runs Friday night and all day Saturday with setup starting on Thursday night. Moms, dads, alums, current students all pitch in to make this day a success. Although a showchoir competition, the funds earned benefit all choir students.
