I'm so excited for the students and this upcoming experience.

Congratulations to Jakob Fung, who was selected as a member of this year's District VII Choir under the direction of Dr. Maggie Burk from Carthage College. He will participate in a festival at Glenbrook South High School on Saturday, November 4.

Many of our choir students are participating in this year's musical, Tuck, Everlasting. Make sure you put aside some time in your schedule to come and see this beautiful show. We have shows at 7pm on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, November 9-11 and a matinee on Saturday at 2pm. There are about eighty students involved in this production, whether on the stage, playing an instrument, or involved in tech crew. About half of the students involved are choir students!

An exciting and busy time of year! The first snowfall has already happened and for sure, the chill is in the air.
